

## PROJECT | HOSPITAL THEATRE REFURBISHMENT PROGRAMME

LOCATION | DUMFRIES ROYAL INFIRMARY

CONTRACT DURATION | 15 MONTHS

The existing 5 main hospital theatres which were originally built c.1975, were upgraded to provide the hospital with surgical facilities that would meet the needs of the Hospital for future generations.

Initially a new purpose built theatre services plant room was installed and commissioned as an enabling package to allow access to upgrade and replace further plant rooms, services equipment and distribution systems. These services upgrades were carried out behind the scenes however were the key providers to deliver the theatre design requirements.

Each of the existing hospital theatres and associated scrub rooms and anaesthetic rooms were stripped back to their basic structure and fully refurbished using the latest materials and technology before being fitted with new specialised equipment. The specification of the finished theatre facilities and equipment was as a result of detailed design and proactive communications with the Hospital Trust Theatre staff ensuring that they received an end product that fully meets their needs.

These works were completed in a phased program with a single theatre being upgraded independently whilst keeping the remaining

theatres operational. Timescale for the project work was 15 months and was delivered on time and to budget.
